- ❖ Deep red skin and bright white flesh
- ❖ Uniform round shape and smaller tuber size (average of 4 oz)

- ❖ Good culinary ratings when baked, boiled, or microwaved-- similar or higher than Chieftain

Deep Red skin and bright white flesh, with an attractive, uniform round shape, moderate eye depth and smaller tuber size (average of 4.0 oz) compared with Chieftain. It has an average of 36% in the <4 oz and 29% in the 4-6 oz categories. It has fewer stems per plant, low yield (just over half) and 99% No. 1s compared with 97% for Chieftain. In general, it has better skin set, tuber size uniformity and less shatter bruise compared with Chieftain otherwise very similar. It has a dark uniform fry color and creamy texture with good flavor when baked, boiled or microwaved.
