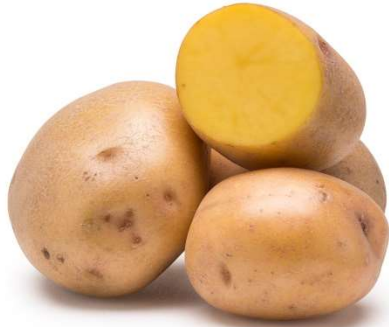

This clone has very attractive tubers with champagne skin and medium yellow flesh. It produces high yields of B sized tubers with an average size of 3 oz. Averaged across all western trial locations, 65% of tubers were <4 oz. and 23% were in the 4-6 oz. range. Tubers are very uniform in size and shape with an appearance similar to apricots. Culinary ratings for baked, boiled and microwaved tubers were similar to or greater than Yukon Gold.
