

Policy for PVMI Participation for Evaluation Purposes

Approved by PVMI Board 4.3.07; Updated 6.7.07

Background – In order to establish serious intentions of potato seed growers in working with the Tri-State Breeding program to evaluate up and coming clones a participation requirement has been established. Prior to the approval of an MTA regarding private evaluation of a pre-released Tri-State variety a grower needs to have either a PVMI participation fee or PVMI license in place. A current license holder has participation rights included in their license fee.

Steps to become a PVMI Participant

1. Nomination
2. Signed Agreement
3. Fee

Nomination

Nominations may come from a member of the Tri-State Breeding Program or the Executive Director of PVMI.

Agreement

PVMI sends an agreement for the grower to sign and returns to PVMI with a check for participation. (See Draft Participation Agreement Form)

Fee

The participation fee is an annual fee, due in advance, equivalent to the annual PVMI License Fee depending on the area that a grower is located.

- \$250 for a Tri-State grower
- \$500 for a US grower outside the Tri-State area
- \$1000 for a non-US grower
