

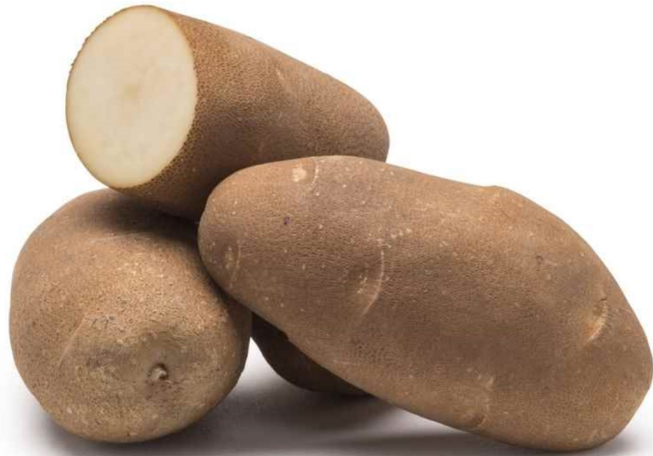
Castle Russet POR06V12-3

- Resistant to PVY
- Resistant to PMTV
- Good culinary quality
- Medium fertility requirements
- Moderate Dormancy
